Things You Might Like To Know About Intergroup

The Intergroup Association includes all groups in the Metropolitan Area, whether they contribute to its support or not. There are now 250 member groups, holding approximately 400 meetings a week.

Pledges and Contributions

Intergroup is supported by pledges and contributions from the groups, usually as a specified amount each month or at intervals during the year.

Delegates

Every six months each group elects a Delegate and an Alternate to Intergroup for a six months' term. Delegates meet at least four times a year. They elect the officers of Intergroup and the members of the Steering Committee which meet once a month to represent all groups and all members.

Your Intergroup Office

The Central Office at 133 East 39th Street employs two full-time and one part-time secretaries. In addition, seven or eight volunteers each day answer the phones and conduct 12th Step interviews.

If a call is urgent, a volunteer at once phones the Secretary of the group nearest to the person calling, or other 12th Step workers listed for that group until contact has been established. A referral form recording all available information is then sent to the group's Secretary, with a copy held at the Intergroup Office.

Every individual who comes in person to the office is spoken to by an A.A. member.

During a typical day the Intergroup Office handles 100 incoming and 50-60 outgoing phone calls; receives 40-50 member and non-member visitors; conducts 25 personal interviews on alcoholic problems, group activities, public relations.

Hospitalization

Approximately 1,000 men and women are hospitalized each year, through the Intergroup Office, at Towns Hospital.

Other Intergroup Services

Meeting Lists: Intergroup compiles, periodically revises and distributes this List now in your hand, as well as "An Introduction to A.A."

Secretaries and Program Chairmen List: Names, addresses, phones of these officers for every group are compiled, mailed to each group every 6 months.

Bulletins: Mailed weekly to each Group, these cover current items of interest to all Area members.

Program Exchange Meetings: Every 3 months these help group officers to "book" speaking teams.

Secretaries and Other New Officers Meetings: In January and July these help new officers to get acquainted and exchange mutually helpful ideas.

Annual Dinner: Here over 2,000 celebrate Bill's anniversary. Proceeds after expenses augment group contributions to support the Intergroup Office.

Public Relations: Intergroup furnishes speakers for educational programs including radio and TV, clubs, churches, universities, doctors, and many others who call on us to help tell the A.A. story.

Institutions Committee: Arranges to carry the A.A. message to alcoholics who cannot come to us because they are in institutions. Also, compiles and distributes monthly institutions bulletin; arranges for quarterly institutions representatives meetings.

Volunteers: Every A.A. member with 3 months or more of solid sobriety is welcomed to share in the volunteer work cleared through and conducted by the Intergroup Office. Pay a visit and help by:

A. *Volunteering for duty at Towns Hospital when your group is asked for this.*

B. *Volunteering for desk duty at Intergroup: Weekdays 10 to 5, Evenings 5 to 8, Sundays and Holidays 12 noon to 6. Tell your Group Secretary you are available for such work.*

There are an estimated 300,000 alcoholics in our area. Any man or woman can phone the Intergroup Office, OR 9-3355, for help or information. Let's all do our part to see that every call is answered and followed through.

HOSPITAL INFORMATION

Certain 12th Step cases desire Hospitalization. For your guidance, the following information is noted here.

FIRST—CALL YOUR INTERGROUP OFFICE FOR RESERVATIONS and further information: ORegon 9-3355. Hours open: 10 A.M. to 8 P.M., Monday through Saturday; Noon to 6 P.M., Sundays and holidays.

Currently, beds have been set aside for A.A. in the following hospital:

TOWNS HOSPITAL

293 Central Park West (bet. 89th & 90th Sts.) N. Y. C.

Male and female patients accepted. 5-day treatment \$100.00 plus \$5.00 deposit for incidentals. Money must be paid in cash to the hospital upon admission, no refunds. Additional charge of \$3.50 is made for pajamas, slippers and robe if patient does not bring his own.

Towns Hospital is open for admission 24 hours a day. When Intergroup Office is closed arrangements may be made direct with Towns Hospital—SCHuyler 4-0770. If patient is eligible for the A.A. plan there, Intergroup will be notified.

SPONSORSHIP

Women patients must be sponsored and visited by women members of A.A. and men patients by men members of A.A. Patients are not allowed to receive visitors other than A.A. members; no phone calls during their 5-day stay.

Since "carrying the message" is such a vital part of A.A. sponsored hospitalization, it is suggested that sponsors visit frequently.

SPECIAL CASES: Sponsors are requested to call Intergroup in connection with any special problems that arise regarding their patients.

These Rules and Regulations have been carefully worked out for the benefit of the greatest number of A.A. members and of prospective A.A. members and the cooperation of all will be gratefully appreciated.

A patient may go only once to the A.A. ward in the above hospital. No repeaters.

The Twelve Traditions

1. Our common welfare should come first; personal recovery depends upon A.A. unity.
2. For our group purpose there is but one ultimate authority—a loving God as He may express Himself in our group conscience. Our Leaders are but trusted servants—they do not govern.
3. The only requirement for A.A. membership is a desire to stop drinking.
4. Each group should be autonomous except in matters affecting other groups or A.A. as a whole.
5. Each group has but one primary purpose—to carry its message to the alcoholic who still suffers.
6. An A.A. group ought never endorse, finance or lend the A.A. name to any related facility or outside enterprise, lest problems of money, property and prestige divert us from our primary purpose.
7. Every A.A. Group ought to be fully self-supporting, declining outside contributions.
8. Alcoholics Anonymous should remain forever non-professional, but our service centers may employ special workers.
9. A.A., as such, ought never be organized; but we may create service boards or committees directly responsible to those they serve.
10. Alcoholics Anonymous has no opinion on outside issues; hence the A.A. name ought never be drawn into public controversy.
11. Our public relations policy is based on attraction rather than promotion; we need always maintain personal anonymity at the level of press, radio and films.
12. Anonymity is the spiritual foundation of all our Traditions, ever reminding us to place principles before personalities.

12 Suggested Steps

1. We admitted we were powerless over alcohol—that our lives had become unmanageable.
2. Came to believe that a Power greater than ourselves could restore us to sanity.
3. Made a decision to turn our will and our lives over to the care of God, as we understood Him.
4. Made a searching and fearless moral inventory of ourselves.
5. Admitted to God, to ourselves and to another human being the exact nature of our wrongs.
6. Were entirely ready to have God remove all these defects of character.
7. Humbly asked Him to remove our shortcomings.
8. Made a list of all persons we had harmed, and became willing to make amends to them all.
9. Made direct amends to such people wherever possible, except when to do so would injure them or others.
10. Continued to take personal inventory, and when we were wrong promptly admitted it.
11. Sought through prayer and meditation to improve our conscious contact with God as we understood Him, praying only for knowledge of His will for us and the power to carry that out.
12. Having had a spiritual awakening as the result of these steps, we tried to carry this message to alcoholics, and to practice these principles in all our affairs.
